Re: *Sibley v. Obama* litigation

The litigation plan I developed a year ago has now entered its execution phase. As promised, I have now filed and properly served three lawsuits. *See*: MontgomeryBlairSibley.com for the details of those suits. As you have seen, these suits give me the platform to issue subpoenas for the records of Mr. Obama from: (i) the U.S. Department of State (passports applications), (ii) Hawaiian Department of State, (iii) the Hawaiian Hospital, (iv) Selective Service Administration, (v) Columbia University, (vi) Harvard University, (vii) Occidental College and (viii) the Social Security Administration. I also have a third suit pending at the U.S. District Court of Appeals from my first *quo warranto* suit: *Sibley vs Obama et al*, U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals Case No.:12-5198. I expect the Court of Appeals will shortly grant the motion for summary affirmance making that suit ripe for petition to the U.S. Supreme Court. In short, I have unleashed all the dogs-of-litigation-war and will see these efforts through to their respective appellate conclusions at the U.S. Supreme Court to the full extent of my resources.

However, while my litigation skill resources are unlimited (and, if I might say, unparalleled), my financial resources are not. I do not seek to be paid for my time and skill, but must have help in paying the various fees and costs associated with this effort if I am to continue this effort.

Hence I write to ask you to use whatever media platform available to you to directly solicit small denomination donations – \$25 to \$50 – for my litigation costs. As you can see from the litigation budget below, I need approximately \$12,600 in fees and printing costs to get all these matters pushed to their ultimate U.S. Supreme Court conclusions before Mr. Obama's swearing-in on January 21, 2013.
